Introduction

This privacy policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) governs how we, Damnbruh LLC (“**Company**”, “**we**”, “**our**” or “**us**”) use, collect and store personal information that we collect or receive from or about you (“**you**”) in connection with our Services provided therein.

By accessing or using our Service, you acknowledge that you have read and understood the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you disagree to any term provided herein, please do not use the Service.

In addition to this Privacy Policy, please also review our Terms of Service, which this Privacy Policy is incorporated thereto by reference, along with such other policies of which you may be notified of by us from time to time. Terms not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Terms of Service.

Nothing in this Privacy Policy is intended to limit in any way your statutory rights, including your rights to a remedy or other means of enforcement.

What Information We Process?

We may collect and process certain information that identifies an individual or may with reasonable effort identify an individual or household (“**Personal Information**”). We treat information that is specifically connected or linked to any Personal Information (if such connection or linkage exists) as Personal Information.

We may also disclose Personal Information we have collected with our service providers for a business purpose (as further detailed in “Business/Commercial Purpose for Collection” section below), subject to a contract that describes the purpose and restricts the use of Personal Information disclosed, or with other third parties for a commercial purpose, which may be considered a sale under the CCPA, as detailed in the following chart:

We may share or transfer Personal Information to third parties as assets that are part of a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy or other transaction in which the third party assumes control of all or part of the Company. Such transfer will be handled according to the requirement of the CCPA and shall not be regarded as a sale of Personal Information under the CCPA.

Sources of Personal Information

In the 12 preceding months, we have collected the above-mentioned categories of Personal Information from the following categories of sources:

- **Directly from consumers**, including when you use our Services, communicate with us or participate in other online interactions with us;
- **Internet service providers**;
- **Operating systems and device platforms**;
- **Payment processors and financial institutions**;
- **Third-party service providers and vendors** that support our business operations.

Purpose for Collection

Company only collects and processes Personal Information in a way that is compatible with and relevant for the purpose for which it was collected or authorized. As a general matter, for all categories of data we collect, we may use the Personal Information we collect:

Disclosure

- To provide, operate, maintain, improve, and personalize our Services;
- To communicate with you, including responding to inquiries, providing customer support, sending service-related messages, security alerts, updates, and administrative notices;
- To send marketing and promotional communications, consistent with your preferences, including information about our products, services, features, offers, surveys, and events (you may opt out at any time);
- To monitor, analyze, and improve usage trends, performance, and functionality, including for analytics, advertising, and measurement purposes;
- To detect, prevent, and investigate fraud, security incidents, unauthorized access, and other illegal activity;
- To comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal processes, and regulatory requests;
- To personalize content, advertisements, and user experiences, including interest-based advertising, where permitted by law;
- To process Personal Information for other purposes disclosed at the time of collection or with your consent.
- To process for other purposes for which we obtain your consent.

We do not sell your Personal Information in exchange for monetary compensation. However, we 'share' certain identifiers (such as IP addresses and cookie IDs) and 'internet or other electronic network activity'

with third-party advertising partners to provide you with personalized, cross-context behavioral advertising. This allows us to show you relevant ads for our Services on other websites you visit. Under the California Consumer Privacy Act, this exchange of information may also be considered a 'sale' because we receive valuable advertising services in return. You may opt out of this activity at any time by clicking our 'Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information' link at the bottom of our homepage.

User Rights under the CCPA

The CCPA provides consumers with specific rights regarding their Personal Information. This section describes your CCPA rights and explains how to exercise those rights.

Access to Personal Information

You may request, up to two times each year, that we disclose to you the categories and specific pieces of Personal Information that we have collected about you, the categories of sources from which your Personal Information is collected, the business or commercial purpose for collecting your Personal Information, the categories of Personal Information that we disclosed for a business purpose, any categories of Personal Information about you that we sold, the categories of third-parties with whom we have shared your Personal Information, and the business or commercial purpose for selling your Personal Information, if applicable.

Deletion Requests

You have the right to request that we delete any Personal Information collected from you and retained, unless an exception applies. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will delete (and direct our service providers, subcontractors, and consultants to delete) your Personal Information, unless an exception applies.

Right to Correct

You have the right to request that we correct inaccurate personal information that we maintain about you, taking into account the nature of the information and the purposes for which it is processed. We will verify your request and respond in accordance with applicable law.

Right to Opt-Out of the Sale of Personal Information

In the event that we sell your Personal Information, You have the right to submit a request to opt-out of the "sale" of your Personal Information. You may change your decision at any time and permit us to sell your Personal Information.

After you opt-out, we may continue to share some Personal Information with our partners (who will function as our service providers in such instance) to help us perform business-related functions such as, but not limited to, providing the Service, ensuring that the Service is working correctly and securely, providing aggregate statistics and analytics and/or preventing fraud. If you access this site (or app) from other devices or browsers, visit the links below from those devices or browsers to ensure your choice applies to the Personal Information collected when you use those devices or browsers.

Additionally, although clicking the "Do Not Sell My Personal Information" link will opt you out of the sale of your Personal Information for advertising purposes, it will not opt you out of the use of previously collected and sold Personal or all interest-based advertising.

We also support your use of the Global Privacy Control (GPC). If you notify us of your privacy preferences through GPC, we will honor your request with respect to the browser or device that sends us the GPC signal.

Exercising Your Rights

You can exercise your rights via our in-app settings, where you can use tools to view, rectify, download, deactivate and delete your data. In addition, to request access to your Personal Information or request deletion of your Personal Information, you can also submit a verifiable consumer request to our email address: support@damnbruh.com.

Only you or a person authorized to act on your behalf may make a consumer request related to your Personal Information.

The request must:

- Provide sufficient information to allow us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected Personal Information or an authorized representative.
- Describe your request with sufficient details to allow us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it.
- We cannot respond to your request or provide you with Personal Information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the Personal Information relates to you. Making a verifiable consumer request does not require you to create an account with us. We will only use Personal Information provided in a verifiable consumer request to verify the requestor's identity or authority to make the request. You may only request a copy of your data twice within a 12-month period.

Response Timing and Format

Our goal is to respond to a verifiable consumer request within 45 days of its receipt. If we require more time, we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing within the first 45 days period. We will deliver our written response, by mail or electronically, at your option. Any disclosures we provide will cover only the 12-month period preceding the request. If reasonably possible, we will provide your Personal Information in a format that is readily useable and should allow you to transmit the information without hindrance.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request.

In case of rejection, the response we provide will explain the reasons for which we cannot comply with your request.

Please note that these CCPA rights are not absolute and requests are subject to any applicable legal requirements, including legal and ethical reporting or document retention obligations.

Designating Agents

You can designate an authorized agent to make a request under the CCPA on your behalf if:

- The authorized agent is a natural person or a business entity registered with the Secretary of State of California; and
- You sign a written declaration that you authorize the authorized agent to act on your behalf.

If you use an authorized agent to submit a request to exercise your right to know or your right to request deletion, please mail a certified copy of your written declaration authorizing the authorized agent to act on your behalf using the contact information below.

If you provide an authorized agent with power of attorney pursuant to Probate Code sections 4000 to 4465, it may not be necessary to perform these steps and we will respond to any request from such authorized agent in accordance with the CCPA.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate you for exercising any of your rights under the CCPA. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

Children's Information

Our Services are not intended for children under the age of 16, or under the applicable age of digital consent in your jurisdiction (the "**Age of Consent**"). We do not knowingly directly collect Personal Information from children without the authorization of a parent or legal guardian, where such authorization is required by law. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Information from a child in a manner that does not comply with applicable requirements, we will delete it. We may request proof of age and, where relevant, proof of parental responsibility/authorization at any time.
